

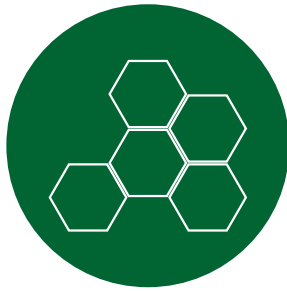

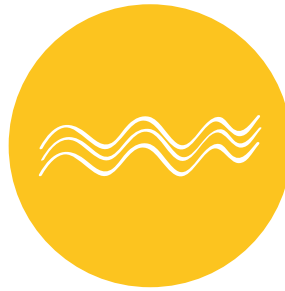

Why study abroad in the UK?

The most effective method of learning the language is by spending a term or full academic year in an English speaking school. The student will benefit immensely by spending time in a class with 25 – 30 Northern Irish pupils. This programme is designed for those who want to perfect their level of English by totally immersing themselves in the daily linguistic and cultural life in Northern Ireland. Due to Coleraine consisting of 20,000 inhabitants, this course is ideal for those children who have not studied outside of their country before.

The UK education system consists of 2 stages

Primary: From 4 - 11 years old. Subjects include: English, Maths, Geography, Science, History, Physical Education, Music and children get many extra- curricular opportunities too.

Secondary: From 11 - 16 years old. In order to complete this stage children must complete GCSE exams being evaluated in 9 subject areas. After completing this stage the student then must enter employment or prepare for the A- Level exams over 2 years from 16- 18 years old.

Coleraine

The duration of the course will take place in Coleraine, a beautiful, peaceful town in the north coast of Northern Ireland, United Kingdom. Coleraine being a small, University town allows it to be a very safe place to live. In addition, it is home to some of the most breathtaking countrysides and views in all of Europe: the Giant's Causeway (UNESCO World Heritage Site) is nearby, visited

by millions of tourists from all over the world on an annual basis. Coleraine has two neighbouring towns in Portstewart and Portrush which are home to spectacular beaches and seaside promenades and pathways. The students will stay with families which are carefully selected allowing for a totally inclusive experience.



Millburn Primary School, Coleraine

Millburn has a total enrolment of 436 pupils, ranging between the ages of 4- 11 years old. It serves a large urban community surrounding the school and a wider rural community. This community has produced an excellent social mix within which warm, happy relationships have blossomed and community/ school links are strong and positive. In Millburn the best is expected for and from every child, every staff member and all who visit or use the school from an academic, social and personal standpoint.

As a school, Millburn has at it's core an ethos of mutual respect, inclusiveness and understanding. Millburn has a long history of embracing other cultures and thus broadening the horizons of children by exploring and encouraging a multicultural dimension. Across all year groups children are taught Mandarin, and Spanish is

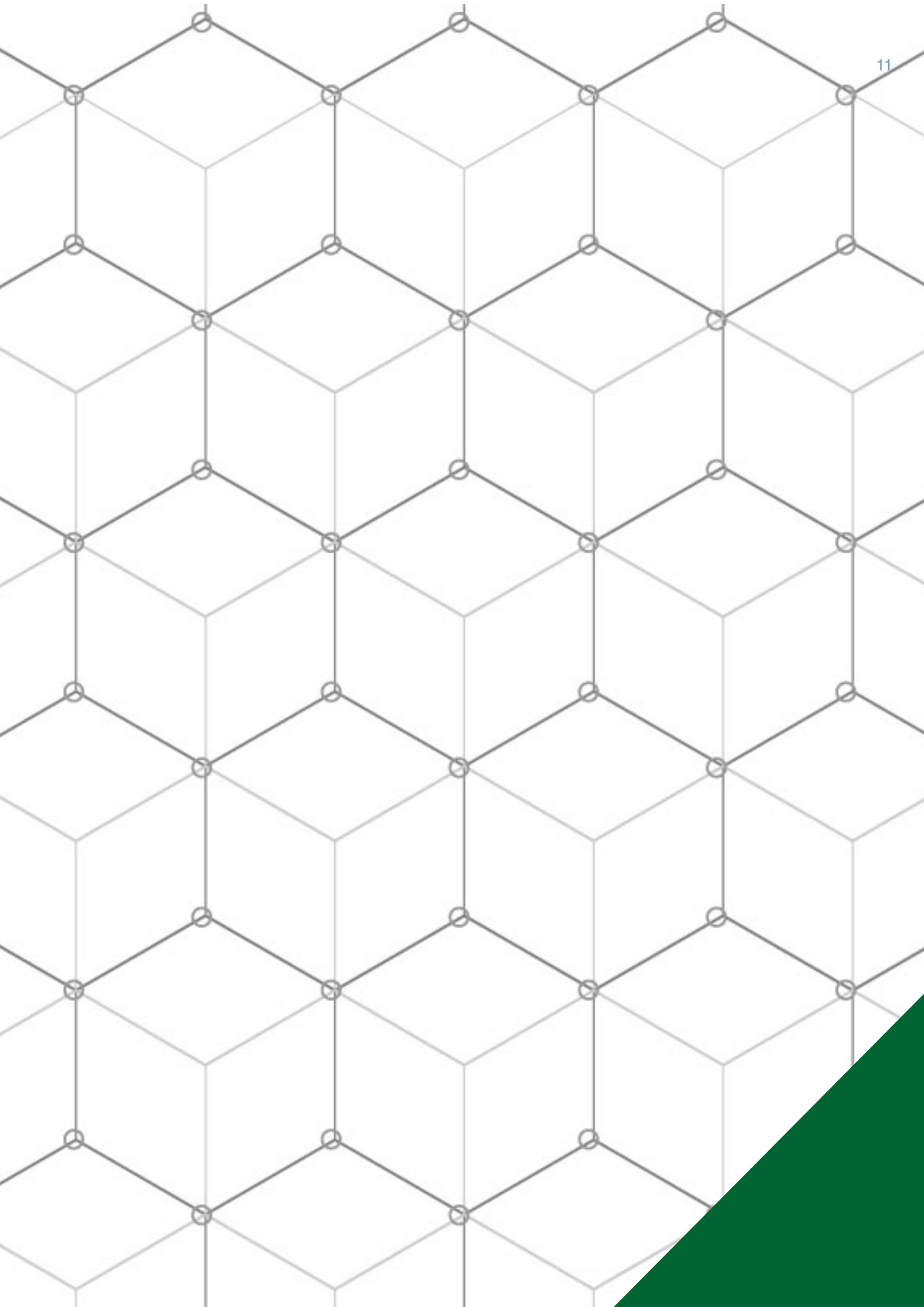
taught from Year 4- 6. In addition, Millburn is the only Confucius Institute Hub in Northern Ireland and is responsible for the teaching of Mandarin in the local area with 5 native Chinese teachers work in the school. Millburn Primary Schools follows the full UK curriculum.

Success is regularly celebrated in school and performance is consistently evaluated in order to seek improvement. In doing so, every individual within the school will personally accept they have the achievement of the school's vision and of their own personal vision. North Coast Integrated, Coleraine

North Coast Integrated College opened in 1996. The common goal was to have an integrated, co- educational, all-ability school. This deliberately equal mix of young people and teachers from differing backgrounds is unique to Integrated schools.
