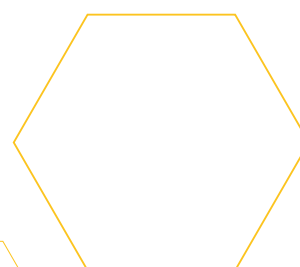
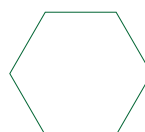

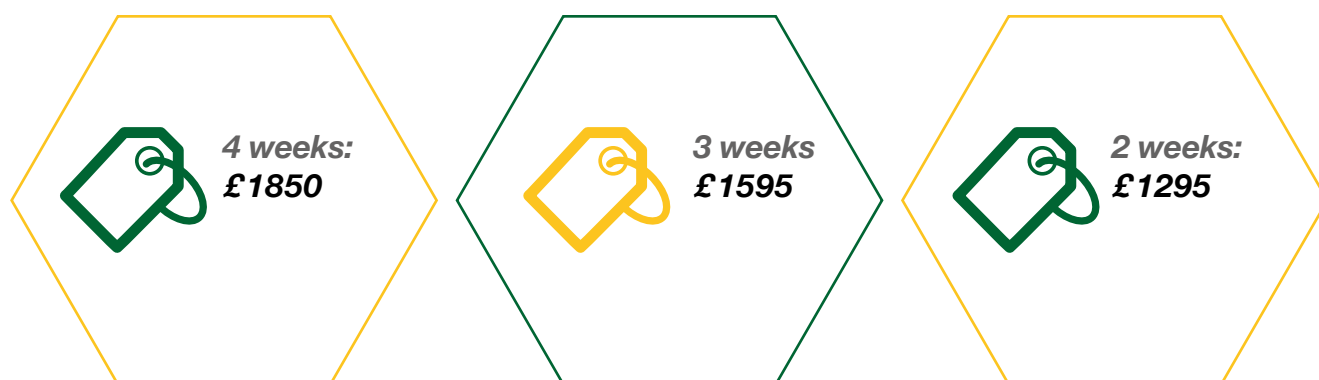
The following programme is a course with dynamic classes with experienced teachers. **The dates will be from 1 - 27th July, 2019 - a duration of 4 weeks.** The course consists of 20 hours per week of class and is designed for children of 10 - 18 years old, who are responsible and are keen to make the most of their stay. Classes are mixed up so they can work on grammar, writing, oral communication and listening all in a very relaxed and friendly environment. The aim is to improve the vocabulary, understanding both oral and written and give the children more confidence and increased level of English while learning about the culture.

Our utmost priority is that the children are safe, having fun and learning English during the month. The small town of Coleraine will help in that as it is

known to be an extremely safe town with only 20,000 inhabitants and very, very few speak a second language. Another major benefit is that we are very lucky to have the sea nearby meaning a lot of the activities are carried out here. All the activities are taken by qualified and experienced monitors with the children's safety in mind.

During our camp the children will spend almost 10 hours per day with the native teachers and monitors. During classes; break and lunch; activities and excursions. To sum up, we don't simply give the opportunity to practise English all day, we offer this in the company of experienced teachers that are available to aid children in any aspect of their language development.

Places

Belfast



Belfast is more vibrant than ever. It is a city of beautiful complexities which is constantly transforming and revealing a new aspect of it's nature. The name "Belfast" is rooted in the Gaelic "Beal Feirste" which means mouth of sandy ford, this is very telling to the city's relationship with the water which provided the city's historic growth. From there Belfast developed a unique and strong history with industry and trade. As the port city ex-panded to be home to the infamous Titanic and it's shipyards! The children will visit the capital city three times and will get the opportunity to do a walking tour, visit the Ulster museum, Titanic shipyards and much more!

Londonderry



Doire, Derry, Londonderry has 1,500 years of history and culture enclosed within Ireland's only completely walled city. From the sixth-century monastic settlement to the vibrant European city of the twenty-first century, no visit to Ireland is complete without a visit to Derry. The children will get the opportunity to visit over fifty natural and built attractions in the region, such as Derry's Walls, The Bogside, The Peoples Gallery (Murals) The Bloody Sunday Story, The History of the Apprentice Boys, The Marching Season Traditions.

Excursions / Activities

Dunluce Castle/ Rope Bridge, Bushmills



We make our way to Dunluce Castle for a photo opportunity. This now ruined medieval castle sits perched on the edge of a basalt cliff and is one of the most picturesque castles anywhere in Ireland.

After lunch we visit the amazing Carrick a Rede rope bridge – where the children can of course cross the bridge which spans a chasm over 75ft in height. The lovely coastal path provides a spectacular walk with stunning sea and cliff views. The perfect place for taking wonderful photos!

Milk Cup, Coleraine, Portstewart, Portrush



The Super Cup NI is an international football competition held in Northern Ireland each July. Teams such as Barcelona, Manchester United, Chelsea, Liverpool, Bayern Munich regularly take part. Notable past players include David Beckham, Ryan Giggs, Radamel Falcao, Sergio Busquets and Mats Hummels. The girls take part in the opening ceremony of the competition in which they parade through the streets with the teams..

Water sports, Causeway Coast Coasteering



Coasteering is an exhilarating combined rock and water activity that can be delivered to every individual level which makes this activity suitable for those with no fear of heights or water as well as those who may not be quite so confident. During the Coasteering trip the children will learn rock climbing and scrambling techniques as well as how to jump from great heights safely.

Wearing sturdy footwear, wetsuits, buoyancy aids and helmets, participants travel along a section of coastline; sometimes swimming in the sea, sometimes scrambling on rocks and jumping from rocks into the sea.

Surfing, Portrush



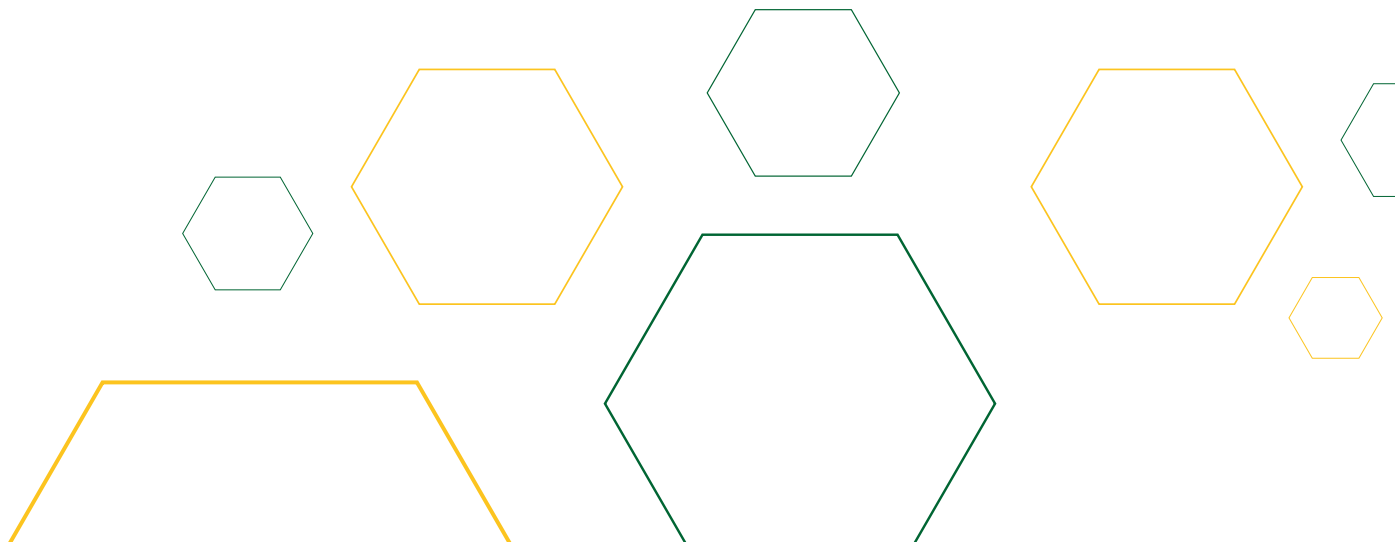
The surf lessons take place in Portrush, Co Antrim, Ireland's premier 'Learn to Surf' location, with a choice of 7 amazing beaches stretching from Downhill to Portballintrae, all with vastly different wave characteristics.

Giant's Causeway, Bushmills



The Giants Causeway, commonly called ‘ the 8th wonder of the world ’ , the Giants Causeway is the only world heritage site in Ireland. During our visit here we spend time climbing over the ancient stones, snapping photos and reflecting on the myths and legends of this very unique area.

In all of the activities the children of the host families can accompany us and even their friends at times! In the camp we see the sports and other activities as another way for the children to learn the language. The classes take place in the wonderful Millburn Primary School in Coleraine with experienced native teachers.

Other Information

Suitcases

Please remember that Ryanair has a very strict policy regarding the weight of the suitcases so your son/ daughter must keep this in mind when they are packing their suitcase. The limits are: 15kg for a checked in suitcase and 10kg for hand luggage. In the case that the suitcases weighs more there is an additional cost per kilo. We do not accept responsibility for this.

Security

As a general rule on any trip, we recommend that the students don't go on any of the activities or trips with large amounts of money or anything of value. Even though the people are generally very honest in Northern Ireland it is important that the children have their belongings within sight at all times. We recommend that the children give the money/ objects to their teachers in order for them to look after it.

Time difference

There is a difference of 1 hour between Italy and Uk. On arrival in Belfast/ Dublin one must turn the clock back 1 hour as in UK we are 1 hour behind.

Lost objects

Please remind your children that it is very important that they look after their belongings. In some cases it will be possible to recover the lost object, for example in the case of a transport tickets. Although in other cases it will be impossible to recover the lost object and we do not take any responsibility for it.

Telephone

In order to make a call from Italy to Uk you must add 00 44, then you must call the number of the province minus the first 0. Mobile devices are the same: 00 44 then the number minus the first 0.

Legislation

Strict laws exist in the UK with respect to under age consumption of alcohol, shoplifting, etc. Your son/ daughter must not break these laws. We cannot take responsibility for any illegal behaviour by any students and may take strong measures if anything like this occurs.

Electrical current

We are sure that your son/ daughter will not travel to the UK without their mobile phone. It is important to know that the British plugs are different to those in Italy. Therefore, in order to use electrical devices an adaptor must be acquired.
